POTTY TRAINING THE KEY TO SUCCESS IS CONTAINMENT



1) SET A TIMER

For every 1-1 ½ hours and take puppy out to potty-reset timer anytime you take puppy out. If puppy is sniffing around or showing they need to potty-take them out before the timer goes off and then reset.

2) MORNING SCHEDULE

Rise early, carry pup from kennel outside immediately and praise when he goes potty. No Cookies Needed!

Tie puppy to your waist with a 10' string and go about your morning duties for 30-60 minutes (if he piddles while tied, shorten the string).

Tie string to doorknob and leave pup with his food and water for 10 minutes.

Take pup outside to potty, untie the string from your waist and let puppy drag it.

Tie puppy to your waist for 30-60 minute playtime.

Take puppy outside to potty, letting string drag.

NAP TIME(MID MORNING AND MID AFTERNOON



Crate puppy for mid-morning nap (2-3 hours) as well as a mid afternoon nap Take Puppy outside to potty, letting string drag after the nap

FTERNOON SCHEDULE

Tie pup to the doorknob for noon feeding. Immediately after take puppy outside to potty, letting string drag.

Tie puppy to your waist for 30-60 minute play time, then take outside to potty.

Crate pup for afternoon nap (2-3 hours).

Take puppy outside to potty, letting string drag with pup outside, let him explore.

Take pup to town for socialization and new sights...or work on socialization activites

Let pup potty then crate him until dinnertime, before feeding take puppy outside to potty, letting string drag.

EVENING SCHEDULE

Tie pup to doorknob for evening feeding.

Take puppy outside to potty, letting string drag, then tie puppy to your waist for 30-60 minute play time, can kennel, can snuggle...

Before retiring late, take pup outside to potty letting string drag.

Crate puppy overnight. (Pups younger than 8 weeks may need to go out in the middle of the night). With this schedule there should be no room for accidents, but if one should occur--it's YOUR fault. Do not discipline the pup. Clean it up with an enzyme cleaner, sold as pet stain remover.

POTTY TRAINING CHECKLIST

SET A TIMER 1-1 1/2 HOURS AND RESTART EVERY TIME YOU TAKE PUPPY OUTSIDE.

MORNING SCHEDULE

- Lunch--Tied to Doorknob/or kennel
- Immediately after take puppy outside to potty,
- Tie puppy to your waist for 30-60 minute
- Puppy outside to potty
- Crate pup for afternoon nap (2-3 hours).
- Take puppy outside to potty
- Take pup to town for socialization and new sights...or work on socialization activities
- potty then crate him until dinnertime, potty before dinner

EVENING SCHEDULE

Dinner--Tied to Doorknob/ or kennel

Take puppy	outside to potty
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- Tie puppy to your waist for 30-60 minute play time, can kennel, can snuggle...
- Before retiring late, take pup outside to potty letting string drag.
- Crate puppy overnight.(Pups younger than 8 weeks may need to go out in the middle of the night).
