

Creative Collage Masterclass

Welcome to my first masterclass with ZPE. ([zeroproofexperiences](#)) We will be creating collage around our Word of The Year. If you do not have a word of the year yet that is okay! I am including a few websites that might inspire you!

What to expect:

This is a beginner class! I hope this class will inspire and ignite your creativity as well as keep your WOTY (Word of The Year) front of mind as you go through 2025. I will teach you how to bargain shop for supplies and work with what you have, make collage papers, use adhesives and glazing techniques. At the end of class, you will have a finished piece of art to hang in your home.

Materials List

Canvas: This can be an actual [Canvas](#) you buy, a piece of cardboard, foam board, old canvas from Goodwill that you will paint over. I like 12 x 12 but buy what you like or what you find!

Watercolors: You don't have to have watercolors; markers will do but water colors are more fun! I like these brands: [Kuretake Gansai Tambi](#) , [Grabie](#) , [Inexpensive set](#)

[White Tissue Paper](#): We will be painting the tissue paper so colored won't work.

[Spray Bottle](#): filled with water.

Markers: Must be water soluble. Examples: [Crayola](#) , [Koiox Dual Tip Markers](#)

Black Gesso and White Gesso Paint: Gesso is an opaque matte paint. You will need the white gesso if you are covering an old canvas. If you have white and black acrylic paint or craft paint that will work too! Options: [White Gesso](#), [Black Gesso](#) Lower priced brands will work.

Modge Podge: [Gloss](#) or [Matte](#) or any art medium like [this](#):

Brushes: [Flat brush](#) and round [brush](#). Do not buy expensive brushes, use what you have!

Old credit card, card stock or index card:

Fan or blow dryer: we will need to quicken the drying process of our tissue paper.

Other optional supplies: magazines to cut out letters or pictures, stamps, colored pencils, letter stencils to make your word of the year.

PREP BEFORE CLASS: This is important! Have your word of the year picked out. This is not a class about picking your word. If you are using a previously worked on canvas, white gesso it before class. Must be dry to work on. Have all your materials out and ready to go!

Where to buy your materials: Shop your home first! Then I would suggest Goodwill or any surplus store. Amazon, Michaels, Joanne's Fabric, Hobby Lobby, Walmart or Art Supply Center.
