Information Collected About Users

If you do choose to access the Website, you are compliant with this Privacy Policy. The Company will learn certain information about you during your visit, both automatically and through the voluntary actions you may take, during your visit. The information is used to better understand how our online visitors use the website.

This policy applies to the information we collect on the Website, in emails, on the app, text, or other electronic messages between you and the Website.

Children Under the Age of 16

Our Website is not intended for use by children under 16 years of age. No one under the age of 16 may provide any information on the Website or to the Company. We do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 16. If you are under 16, do not use any features, provide any information, make any purchases, use any of the interactive or public comment features or provide any information about yourself to us on this Website. This includes providing your name, address, telephone number, email address, or any screen name or username you may use for identification purposes.

Information Collected About You

We collect information about users in various places on the Website when you fill out contact forms, respond to surveys, use the search feature, provide comments or feedback, and when you provide information because you have purchased a product or service via the Website.

We use the information you provide to deliver the requested product and/or service, to improve our overall performance, and to provide you with offers, promotions, and information. In the case of personally identifying information like Internet Protocol (IP) addresses for users who are logged in or leaving comments on our blogs or websites, we only disclose the IP addresses and/or email addresses to the contracted administrators of our owned blog or site where the activity has taken place.

In so far as those visitors who choose to engage in a transaction with KMcNea & Company Inc. and are required to provide personal and financial information in order to process those transactions, only information necessary or appropriate to fulfill the purpose of the visitor's interaction will be collected. Data Collection Technology

Like most website operators, KMcNea & Company Inc. collects non personally identifying information. We may use automatic data collection technologies including Google Analytics to collect certaininformation about your location and IP address, computer equipment and operating system, language preferences, date and time of each visit, browsing type and actions traffic patterns.

Anonymous Information Collection:

Similar to other commercial websites, we utilize a standard technology called "cookies" and server logs to collect information about how this site is used. Information gathered through cookies and server logs may include the date and time of visits, pages viewed, length of time spent on the site, and the websites visited just before and just after you visit our Website.

The Company may use cookies and similar technologies like pixels and web beacons on our platforms to automatically collect anonymous information that is generated from your device, such as a computer's Internet Protocol address, a mobile device identifier, operating system, or general locater such as a zip or postal code. As a user moves from a web page or screen to another, a cookie ("cookie") is used to verify that it is the same device. Cookies also keep track of user selections. Devices can be set to accept cookies, which can then be deleted, or devices can be set to not accept them. Be aware that if cookies that have been placed on your device by our platform are disabled, you may not be able to use certain services or features. A web beacon ("web beacon") may also provide us with information about page usage or e-mail message acceptance. Some information is collected through third-party analytics tools. Analytical information collected by the Company as outlined above is used to better understand, monitor and improve performance of our Platforms and support internal operations.

Individual user information is not made publicly available. We only disclose personally identifying information to employees, contractors for internal operations support and affiliate organizations that (i) need to know the information in order to process a transaction on the Company's behalf; and (ii) that have agreed not to disclose the information to others. By using the Company's websites, you consent to the transfer of such information to them.

Internal operations support includes:

- Metrics monitoring (i.e. total number of visitors/traffic at any given time);
- Landing page analysis (i.e. visitor site entrance, pages viewed, frequency)
- Popularity of site activities and services;
- User location (e.g., zip/postal code information);
- Browser identification and adaptation
- Technological diagnostics and repair

We may release generic, non-personally-identifying information in the aggregate such as publishing a general report on website usage trends.

How Your Information and Secure Transmission Are Protected We employ commercially reasonable methods to ensure security of the information you provide to us and the information we collect automatically. This includes using standard security protocols and working only with reputable third-party vendors.

Email is not recognized as a secure medium of communication. For this reason, we request that you do not send private information to us by email.
